



ANTENATAL CLASSES Preparing for your birth



Welcome to the IPMC Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology. We provide excellent treatment and care for patients with normal and high-risk pregnancies, and we offer a wide scope of services that addresses every healthcare phase a woman experiences throughout her lifetime from pre-reproductive care through the childbearing and post-menopausal years. For first time parents, Antenatal Classes usually commence on the 28th week of gestational age onwards. We also offer refresher antenatal classes.

The Antenatal classes will familiarise you and your partner on what to expect during labour and delivery. The role of your birth companion will be discussed. And they will be encouraged to take part in discussions about caring for your baby and adjusting to life as a parent.

The classes can also be the beginning of starting new friendships with other parents of similar aged children. A great place too, to meet other parents-to-be.

Antenatal classes can help you focus on your pregnancy and get you ready for labour and child birth.

The Maternity Team will welcome you to these most valuable classes and look forward to working with you in your planning and preparation for the delivery of your baby.

Lactation Classes

This class runs for 2 hours. Date and time of class will be arranged between you and Lactation Nurses. 1st time consultation is BND30. The topics for this class will include:
